



CLEAN WATER FOR THE VILLAGE OF ASSO IN TOGO, WEST AFRICA

The partners of Support. Education. Togo. (SET) and Ryan's Well Foundation (RWF) are pleased to announce a new water project in the village of Asso, Togo, West Africa.

SET recently funded a school project which consisted of a new three classroom school building with a principal's office and storage area. This school project was completed in October, 2012. As there is no water or washroom facilities at the school site, RWF is currently fundraising for the building of a new well, latrines and hand washing station at the new school site. Clean water is extremely important for the children and community. The current water supply comes from shallow wells and is not suitable for drinking.

Asso is a remote village of about 2,500 people located 70 kms from Lome, the capital of Togo.

SET and RWF's partner in Togo is Action Enfance et Developpement Togo (AED) . AED has worked for several years with SET building schools and with RWF in support of water supply, latrines and handwashing stations. AED is a registered charity based in Lome.
